My name is Robert Paust and for the last 19 years I have been living with my wife and 4 children in Sweden.

That summer I had a job working in a local dog kennel, for Robert Clyde. It was here that I started learning the care and grooming of dogs. We groomed a lot of pets' dogs as well as show dogs. This is where I started learning how to trim terriers, Giant Schnauzers, Bouviers and how to groom Afghan Hounds. My first visit to a dog show was during this time and when my boss became a professional handler, I was his assistant.

1977 I started working for the world renowned terrier man Peter Green. I worked for Peter for 11 years. My work included managing his kennel, trimming show dogs, breeding and raising litters of puppies and working as his show assistant.

I met my future wife in 1988 and moved to Sweden in 1990. My wife and I have owned several Afghan Hounds, Whippets, Dandie Dinmont terriers and an Italian Greyhound. Two of our Afghans Ch. Alphaville's Bladerunner and Ch. Alphaville's Walk Like A Man, were both top winning dogs when they were shown. Our whippet, Ch. Hubbestad Double Dutch, was a best in show winner.

I have shown a good number of other Sighthound breeds, especially Greyhounds and many terriers while living in Sweden.

I have been an approved judge for six years and have judged in the USA, Ireland, Australia, Slovenia, Spain, Finland, Norway, Sweden and England. My assignment in Australia was to judge the Afghan Club of New South Wales.

I am looking forward to my assignment in Denmark during the World Show and hope we all have a wonderful day together.
